

INTERNSHIP RESEARCH PROGRAM HARVARD - U. MAYOR

This program seeks to make Universidad Mayor's research centers available for Harvard students via internships (summer or winter semesters), capitalizing on the university's strengths in topics such as climate change, sociocultural and political changes.

Interns will gain 'hands on' experience working in top-level research centers, conducting experiments in laboratories, learning new methodologies, performing fieldwork, and applying their creativity in different research areas, under the guidance of a senior researcher and interacting with prestigious national and international researchers embedded in multidisciplinary teams, all of which will deeply enrich the applicant's professional development.

Harvard students that apply to this program can perform their internships in the following research centers:

- GEMA Center for Genomics, Ecology and Environment
- Center for Ecosystem Modelling and Monitoring

Universidad Mayor provides a travel grant to selected interns, which includes a round-trip ticket from the USA to Chile and a per diem to cover living expenses for up to one month.
